They investigate cases, rescue animals in distress, work with law enforcement and prepare court cases to hold offenders accountable.

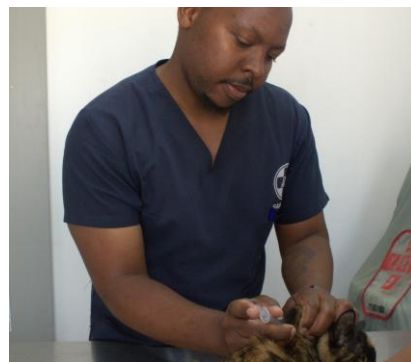

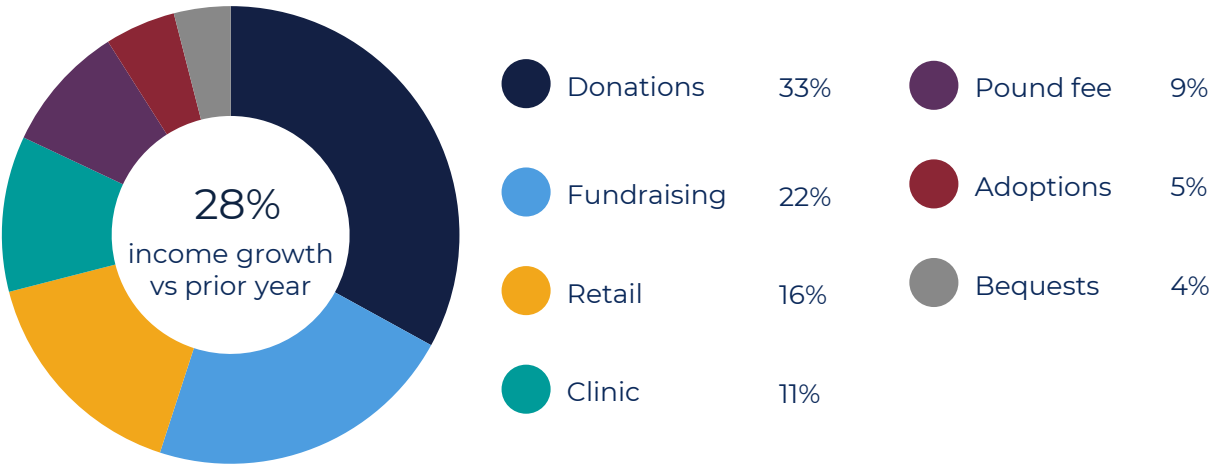

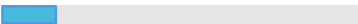

WHY NOW

South Africa's economic pressures (rising unemployment, increasing urbanisation, the affordability crisis) are driving a surge in animal abandonment.

Call volumes have grown by 30% over two years.

The cost of prevention is always lower than the cost of rescue. *Act now.*
